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~ Sculptra® Earns FDA Approval for Cosmetic Use ~

While the injectable filler Sculptra has been in use for several years as an FDA-approved solution for facial atrophy, this past July it received FDA approval for cosmetic use — offering a new and long-lasting option for correcting nasolabial folds (smile lines) and other facial wrinkles.

"Sculptra produces natural-looking results that can last up to two years," says Dr. Jochen, noting that most other fillers last for only about six months.

"Plus, Sculptra is the first facial injectable to produce gradual results, so there's no sudden or dramatic 'before-and-after' effect," he adds. "Instead, it's a subtle transformation."

Well-documented results

The FDA originally approved Sculptra in 2004 to help restore facial volume in HIV-positive patients

who experienced facial wasting. The more recent FDA approval of Sculptra® Aesthetic (the name of the filler for cosmetic use) is based on results from a study of 233 patients who received either Sculptra Aesthetic or human-derived collagen for the treatment of nasolabial folds. The Sculptra Aesthetic results were maintained up to 25 months, while the human-derived collagen was effective up to only three months.

Because the manufacturer of Sculptra Aesthetic has lowered its prices, Contour is passing the savings on to you. Sculptra Aesthetic is now available for \$500 per vial (it was \$650 - a savings of \$150!).

~ New Laser Acne Treatment Option at Contour ~

If traditional topical or oral therapies for acne haven't worked for you, or you'd simply like an alternative treatment, Contour is pleased to offer elōsTM Acne Treatment. Using a new AC Applicator (the AC stands for "acne clearance") powered by elōs technology, this treatment uses a specific spectrum of light that targets the bacteria that cause acne.

"When acne-causing bacteria clog pores, it can cause bumpy and inflamed acne lesions," explains Dr. Jochen. "The AC combines light and gentle radio-frequency energies to 'zap' these bacteria. It also reduces the over-production of oil in the sebaceous glands and promotes healing of the skin after an acne break-out."

AC Applicator treatments are performed twice a week for four to six weeks. Each treatment session takes about 15 minutes, and the sensation is often described as a "hot pinch" that lasts for a fraction of a second, followed by brief warmth

or a tingling sensation. The cooling tip of the applicator makes the treatment comfortable – most patients do not use any topical anesthetic. And there's virtually no downtime – most patients experience some temporary skin redness following treatment, but they can return to regular activities right away.

"Most patients report a noticeable improvement as early as three weeks into the treatment schedule," Dr. Jochen notes. "This is one of the safest acne treatment systems available, and it's appropriate for all skin tones and types," he adds.

Autologous Fat Transfer (also called Fat Graffing)

— Fat taken from one's own body is one of the safest, most commonly used substances for filling facial wrinkles, and it's very effective for "plumping up" under-eye hollows. The fat used for this procedure is removed by liposuction from another part of the body and reinjected beneath the eyes.

Blepharoplasty – This is the medical term for surgery of the eyelids. In this procedure, excess skin and fat around the eyes is removed to improve their appearance. The incisions are hidden in the natural creases of the upper eyelids and just below the eyelashes of the lower eyelids. The lower eyelid incision can be completely hidden inside the eyelid when only fat removal is required.

Lumiere Bio-restorative Eye Cream – This intensive line-smoothing eye cream also helps reduce puffiness and dark circles.

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~ New Drug Promises to Ease the "Heartbreak of Psoriasis" ~

As a dermatologist, one of the most challengina conditions I treat is psoriasis. This incurable, recurring disease of the immune system can strike at any age, causing dry, painful skin lesions that itch. crack and bleed.

A new injectable drug called Stelara™ was recently approved by the FDA for patients 18 years or older with moderate to severe psoriasis. It's the first of a new type of biologics therapy that promises to provide powerful relief with infrequent dosing. It works by targeting specific processes in the immune system that trigger disease flare-ups.

Stelara is administered by injection under the skin as few as four times a year after two initial doses in the first month. This less-frequent dosing is certainly an advantage that will be welcomed by psoriasis patients.

This new drug's safety profile also has been

impressive in the studies conducted to date. Stelara has about three years of clinical testing data in humans, and it has proven very effective in clinical trials lasting up to one year. Only time (and longer studies) will show if the drua can maintain this effectiveness over time.
