~The Mini Facelift by Dr. Jochen ~ **Minimal Surgery, Maximum Results**

Have you ever found yourself standing in front of your bathroom mirror in the privacy of your own home pulling back the skin near your jaw to see what vou'd look like with tighter skin and wishing it would stay that way?

Maybe you were even among those, who, when younger, said "I will never get a facelift." But now, you are middle-aged and the gravity of the years is starting to show and you're interested in doing something about it.

The concerns most people have about getting a facelift include: the cost, risks of anesthesia, scars and not wanting to look "done." The mini facelift that Dr. Jochen performs addresses all of those concerns.

What is a Mini Facelift?

A mini facelift corrects sagging jowls and laxity in the lower two-thirds of the face. It restores a youthful jaw and neckline and patients often comment that they look at least 10 years younger. Unlike the wind-tunnel results of the past, the mini facelift not only pulls back sagging skin, it also attaches the underlying muscle tissue, providing support for long-lasting results. Dr. Jochen neatly positions the incision around the ears, so the scar is virtually unnoticeable.

Surgery and a member of the American Society for Cosmetic Dermatology and



~ Hair Transplants Deliver Confidence as Well as New Hairline ~



As Principal of Ronald Reagan Elementary School in Palm Desert, Mark Baldwin inspires students to be well educated and self-confident. He oversees a team of 39 teachers and a support staff of 50 to serve more

than 800 students. Mark has plenty of reasons to be confident in his leadership abilities and educational career of nearly 20 years and has been recognized as Principal of the Year several times over the years.

A few years ago, though, Mark began to feel self-conscious about his receding hairline. When he glanced in the mirror, even though he looked young, all he would notice was his hairline. "I was becoming sensitive

about my hair loss."

The Decision

In late 2008, he decided to do something about it. He met with three different surgeons,



including the Bosley Clinic, and ultimately selected Dr. Timothy Jochen of Contour Dermatology to do perform his hair transplant.

The Procedure

Mark had a 2,000 micrograff hair transplant during the Thanksgiving holiday week when he could take some time off from school. During a pre-op visit, Dr. Jochen explained the entire process to him – how long the surgery would take, what to expect during and after the procedure along with post-surgical instructions. As Dr. Jochen uses local anesthesia, patients are fully awake for the surgery. In addition, sedatives are prescribed to make them more relaxed during the procedure.

The Recovery

"I did have some swelling in my forehead and I was sore for the first few days," Mark recalled. "I had the stubbles sticking out, most of which died off and left the hair follicle behind," he explained. "I was patient. I knew from the get-go that it would take a few months for the new hair to grow in."

The Results

"I think Dr. Jochen did a great job. It's very natural," said Mark. "It looks good, it wears fine, it grows fine and it cuts fine." Initially, the only person he told about his hair transplant besides immediate family was his hairdresser, as he can't wear his hair quite as short as he used to because of the scar in the back.

Maintenance

Now three and a half years later, Mark is still enjoying the results of his new hairline. Because the transplanted hair is harvested from the back of the head, it is genetically resistant to hair loss.



However, having a hair transplant does not stop the progression of hair loss in other areas, which is why medications may be recommended.

"All I do now is use the Nioxin products — a cleanser, scalp therapy and two treatment boosters. I was using Rogaine for a while, but I haven't continued with that," he admitted.

"My hairline is better now than when I got married eight years ago," said Mark. "I would recommend Dr. Jochen to anyone considering this procedure." He also added, "I would consider having another transplant in the future if my hair thins too much in certain greas."

In the meantime, Mark makes sure to visit Dr. Jochen for his annual mole/skin cancer checkup and for non-surgical skin rejuvenating treatments.

~ Top Five Filler Mistakes ~

Hyaluronic acid fillers were the number two most popular non-invasive cosmetic procedure in 2011, second only to Botox. A big part of our practice at Contour Dermatology is helping people look younger with dermal fillers. I am proud to report that as of April

2012, Contour Dermatology is in the top 1% of dermal filler injectors as well as the top 1% of Botox injectors out of more than 7,200 injectors in the in the nation.

My experience in facial rejuvenation dates back to residency at Tulane University in New Orleans in the

1990s where I trained with one of the top injectors of autologous fat transfer. I saw the amazing transformation that is possible by restoring volume to a person's face. The newer hyaluronic acid fillers today are even better than fat and have more predictable results. There's never been a better time to stay younger looking than now! While experience is important, it is

equally important to select an injector who has an artistic eye. I want to share with you my approach to facial fillers as well as discuss some of the mistakes I have seen in the cosmetic industry.

Underfilling – Lack of 3-D Evaluation

The first common mistake I see is not addressing the entire face. We are three-dimensional beings. It's not just how you look when you look at yourself in the mirror, your profile also matters when someone looks at you from the side. I take this into account when determining the areas for injection.

Overfilling

One of the most remarkable areas for improvement is the tear trough underneath the eyes. The hollowness that comes with age can be dramatically

restored. However, too much filler in this area is worse than no filler at all. Too much filler in the cheeks is also a telltale sign that someone has had work done.

Too Much Filler in the Lower Third of the Face

When we are young, we enjoy what scientists call the triangle of youth. Unfortunately, when we age, this triangle inverts and becomes the pyramid of age.

You've heard the saying "everything goes south with age." So filling in wrinkles and folds is a good thing, right? Yes, but too much filler or only filling the lower third of the face, actually does the opposite of what people want. It can masculinize a woman's face and make the lower portion of the face heavier, drawing attention away from the eyes.

Lips

I'm sure most of you have read about the disastrous results of liquid silicone, a permanent filler which lead to monkey-like lips in the '70s and '80s. I take a conservative approach to lip filling and fill not just the lips but around the lips – successfully reducing lipstick lines,

restoring deflation and correcting the downturn of the outer commissures - all with a goal of looking natural and proportional.

Asymmetry

When I see a new patient who has had filler elsewhere and is not satisfied, if the problem is asymmetry, this is usually corrected either by adding filler or dissolving a hyaluronic acid filler with the enzyme hyaluronidase, which can be used even months after initial injection.

Summary

As with all injections, the goal is balance and harmony. I want patients to look refreshed and natural – better, but not different.
